

Cleburne County Shooting Club, Inc.

Minutes of Board of Directors Meeting:

February 7, 2026

The meeting was called to order at 2:05 pm by Scott Swain.

Board members present: Scott Swain, Steven Hamilton, John Hale, Greg Hill, Muncy Zuber, and Ron Salyer. Julie Murray was absent. Karen Swain was present to take minutes in Julie's place.

Skeet Field:

Scott presented a proposal from David Cardenas to rebuild the concrete walkways and stations on the #2 combination skeet/trap field, including re-landscaping and leveling the field, using heavy equipment and additional fill dirt. This will be done for \$600 per day for labor plus materials. The project is estimated to take a maximum of 5 days.

Muncy Zuber made a motion to accept the bid; Steven Hamilton seconded the motion. The motion was **approved** unanimously.

Club Sign at Entrance:

The existing sign is in poor condition and on the verge of collapse. After a long discussion, the board decided to explore new, stronger construction and installation, specifically steel post construction. A company to build and install the framework has yet to be identified.

Steven will investigate a design for the sign.

Hold Harmless signs:

The effectiveness of the existing hold harmless sign located on the entrance gate was discussed. It is acknowledged that many people may not notice the sign when entering because their focus is on the keypad. Another sign will be added at the bottom of the hill leading from the entrance into the range.

Target Stands:

A new system will be initiated at the pistol range using the existing 10 metal bases which are in storage. Greg said additional dirt barriers need to be placed in front of the target stand sockets at the rifle range. Dirt will be brought in to protect the target receptacles.

Generator:

Scott reported that the search for a replacement for the non-working generator continues. Finding an appropriate replacement locally has been extremely challenging.

Stop the Bleed Course:

Steven has volunteered to conduct a "Stop the Bleed" course. The course will be limited to about 10 people due to the nature of his hand-on-training instruction. Steven will submit information regarding the cost and number of training kits and supplies needed.

Insurance:

The board was reminded that CCSC has commercial liability insurance through Lockton Affinity (through the NRA). The club still does not have property insurance due to the lack of insurance companies that offer it to begin with, and then the additional requirements such as alarm systems, etc.

Treasurer's Assistant:

Karen Swain announced that she is resigning as the Treasurer's Assistant, effective March 21st. However, certain options were presented.

The meeting was adjourned at 4:15 pm.
